

The 2017 Annual Noxious Weed Survey has been completed and received by the KGCA-ACC. The findings and eradication needed is described below.

Noxious Knapweed and Thistle are growing prevalently in our community. These two especially noxious weeds need to be removed. Knapweed seeds remain viable for 10 years, so the problem will continue if not dealt with quickly. The plants should be pulled and disposed of in a place the seeds can't spread (garbage or the bottom of a burn pile). It is too late to poison; they are too large and too close to going to seed.

The noxious weed plant go to seed the first to mid part of August. It has been standard in the past to give a 30 day notice to our community lot/home owners to remove noxious weeds (before the board directs CAST to do it then billed to the lot/home owner).

We ask that you please deal with killing and removing the Knapweed and Thistle on your property (which includes drainage ditch area) as soon as possible.

Please remember to NOT put these plants on a compost pile, or leave them exposed because even after being pulled they will continue to go to seed and spread via wind.
